I. Get Ready to Hear and Do (Deut. 6:1-6).

- A. Background to chapter 6
 - 1. Deut. 4:1 “And now, O Israel, listen to the statutes and the rules that I am teaching you, and do them, that you may live ...”
 - 2. Deut. 5:1 “And Moses summoned all Israel and said to them, “Hear, O Israel, the statutes and the rules that I speak in your hearing today, and you shall learn them and be careful to do them.” (Moses then repeats the 10 commandments in Deut. 5:7-21.)
- B. Deuteronomy 6:1-3
 - 1. It’s for your FAMILY.
 - 2. It’s for LIFE.
 - 3. It’s for BLESSINGS.
- C. Deuteronomy 6:4-6
 - 1. We must HEAR (v. 4).
