Let's Get Started

A. Genesis 1-2: The Creation

1. The creation was GOOD (light (1:4); dry land and seas (1:10); vegetation (1:12); sun, moon, stars (1:18); land, sea, and flying creatures (1:21); creeping things and beasts of the earth (1:25); everything was VERY good! (1:31).
2. Man (male and female) were created in the IMAGE of God (1:27)

B. Genesis 3: The Fall

I. What do we learn about Adam & Eve (and Ourselves)? (Gen. 3)

- A. They are attracted to PLEASURE (Gen. 2:23; 3:6).
- B. They have a CONSCIENCE.
(3:7 Their eyes “were opened, and they realized they were naked”)
- C. When they sin, they try to HIDE (Gen. 3:8).
- D. They can be DECEIVED (Gen. 3:13; cf. 2 Cor. 11:3; 1 Cor. 15:33-34; 1 John 1:8; 3:6-8).
- E. They quickly BLAME someone else (Gen. 3:12-13).
- F. They do STUPID things.
 1. Gen. 2:9 And out of the ground the Lord God made to spring up every tree that is pleasant to the sight and good for food. The tree of life was in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.
 2. Gen. 2:16 “You may surely eat of every tree of the garden.”
 3. **BUT** – They BLEW it.
 - a. DEATH came (Gen. 3:19).
 - b. They were KICKED OUT (Gen. 3:22-24).

II. What do we learn about the Serpent? (Gen. 3:1-5)

- A. The serpent is CRAFTY (Gen. 3:1a; Eph. 6:11).
Gen. 3:1a “more crafty than any of the wild animals the Lord had made.”
Eph. 6:11 “Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the SCHEMES of the devil.”
- B. The serpent is SUBTLE.
Gen. 3:1b “Did God really say, ‘You must not eat from any tree ...?’.”
- C. The serpent is DECEPTIVE with half-truths (Gen. 3:4-5; 2 Cor. 11:3).
- D. The serpent is destined to ultimate DEFEAT (Gen. 3:14-15; Heb. 2:14-15; 1 John 3:8; Rev. 12:9).
1. He is CURSED (Gen. 3:14).
 2. He will have constant CONFLICT (Gen. 3:15a).
 3. He will be overcome at the CROSS and at the final JUDGMENT (Gen. 1:15b; Heb. 2:14-15; 1 John 3:8; Rev. 12:9).

III. What do we learn about God?

- A. God COMES to us.
(Gen. 3:8 “walking in the garden”)
- B. God is CONCERNED about us.
(Gen. 3:9 “Where are you?”)
- C. God CARES enough to warn us.
(Gen. 2:17 “... in the day you eat [of the tree], you shall surely die”)
- D. God holds us ACCOUNTABLE.
(Gen. 3:11 “Have you eaten from the tree that I commanded you not to eat from?”)
- E. God PROVIDES, even when he punishes (Compare Gen. 3:7 with Gen. 3:21).
